SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AND GUIDELINES

The NBPPA Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to high school seniors or college/trade school students who meet the following eligibility criteria.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Be a graduating high school senior or college/trade school student;
2. Be committed to attending a two- or four-year college, university or trade school; and
3. Be a current member of the NBPPA or have a relative that is an active member.

Scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis and disbursed in a lump sum payment to the university, college or trade school of choice in September of the award year. Scholarship recipients must continue to attend classes and maintain a passing grade.

The committee of NBPPA board members will determine the scholarship amount awarded each year. Depending on the number of eligible recipients, scholarship amounts may vary but may be up to \$500 for each awarded student. More than one scholarship could be awarded each year. Recipients may apply for and receive the scholarship for up to four academic years.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION SUBMISSION

The deadline to submit scholarship applications is August 1 of each calendar year. Applications postmarked after August 1 will not be accepted. The NBPPA Scholarship Committee will use the postmark date to determine mailed entries.
